I'm gonna say two minutes after it happened, we went straight to the jeep Cherokee that is a brand new 2024 car, and there were a total of seven people inside of the vehicle only one person didn't make it well she was the grandma that was in the passenger seat. She perished in the impact collision. She failed to show up. I saved a total of four people out of the seven people that was inside the car and the other car that was in the accident, it was one person inside and didn't look inside there were somebody inside the car didn't make it because the head on collision of the Impact but both cars started smoking cracking like regular crash still but no ordinary car accident you country I'm not gonna say it the police department probably 20 minutes then the helicopter came. The part about the fire arrived. Both vehicles are on fire.Remember there are two bodies: one inside the white jeep and one inside the black car. After the fire was extinguished, both bodies were discovered. There was a young boy involved in the accident who was in the white car with the family. The little boy was braver than I could be lol. The little boy's toilet had

been cut. He had a broken elbow. There were many stitches on his face, but the nine-year-old girl inside the car survived. However, there was a baby who appeared to be newborn but could walk. She burst out crying. She could not stop crying until my sister arrived, and the baby and my sister's arms stopped crying altogether. This day was unexpected, but life is a book, and you never know what will happen in the next chapter. You must persevere; this is not my first car or truck. I was happy in my Toyota Tacoma, and I had never been in an accident like that in my life, nor had I ever been pulled over, but what I am trying to say with this entire road trip story is to be cautious on the road. Be cautious on the highways because you never know what will happen after the accident. We returned to my house to calm down and relax, and we decided to sleep there around 5 a.m. because I had school the next day and was nervous at night that I would hit a deer. At 5 a.m. today, October 23, my mother called me. off-topic She was driving my sister to her soccer practice. She had a flat tire, which she was unaware of. She thought it was a rock that hit the defender and continued on later. She had gotten the car. She had a flat tire that was down to the rim should call three dads from the soccer team to come help her out because she can't change the flat tire she doesn't wanna change the flat tire that's so man's job not a woman's job but what I'm trying to say in this situation again you don't know what's gonna happen next you have to keep living but if you go on the news, can you look at accidents? You don't really feel it but when you're involved in the accident, you really do feel how badly you want to save that person. I regret not trying hard enough to save the person, the grandma that was in a passenger seat, I still regret to this day and my mom was holding me back because she was dead. She passed away from the impact of the two cars that caught on fire. I could've done anything. The class wouldn't break the door wouldn't open. The car was leaking oil and starting to be on fire, I still pray I don't see like that but that also made me see a firefighter or a policeman do their job by seeing a bad accident happened in front

of your eyes right in front of you you can't remember what what happened You can't forget that I'm stuck with you. I wish that a credit done better situation. I was helping out. I was helping with the fire department but if you look into Dallas Houston Austin, these big cities and Texas compared to Mississippi the country is only two big cities is Jackson and Bruce Mississippi or Tupelo again 20 minutes to 35 minutes to get a police officer on site or a fire department to come on site of the scene of the accident but if you were in Dallas or Houston, the police or the fire department would've been less than 30 seconds I'm trying to say is time is ticking and the fire department in the police department the civilians put their trust into them to save their family, their friends and community but I never thought of being asked myself but I hope no one witnesses the feelings that I had over this car accident that I had back then and recently had a back then but life is a book.
